Construction Update

The Contractor is currently completing the scheduled work for the 2024 construction season and intends to demobilize from site in mid-December 2024 (barring any unforeseen issues and weather permitting). Full construction activities will resume in Spring 2025. The public should anticipate some construction activity over the winter months as utility providers will be performing work relating to the relocations of their infrastructure as part of the project.

The electronic message boards and detour signage that were installed have been removed off site to avoid impacting winter maintenance being performed by the Town.

Vehicle Traffic

Motorist are reminded that they are required to observe and obey all traffic controls that are in place. Motorists are encouraged to slow down and familiarize themselves with the new road layout and traffic control measures that are in place. We ask that everyone take extra caution during the winter period, to ensure everyone's safety.

Pedestrian and Cyclist Traffic

Cyclists are reminded that they are required to observe and obey all traffic controls that are in place. Pedestrians are advised to take extra caution as not all of the new sidewalk has been installed. Sidewalk Closed Signage has been installed in areas that are not accessible to the public. Pedestrians are required to observe and obey any restrictions that are in place for their own safety.

The Town and Contractor have made every effort to make as much sidewalk accessible to the public as possible. The Town's operations department will be performing winter maintenance on any sidewalks within the limits of construction that are open to the public.

How will Access to my Property be Affected?

Access to your property should not be impacted by any construction activity being performed over the winter, barring any unforeseen circumstances. Where work is located within driveways or entrances to dwellings and/or businesses, temporary access will be provided. Full access will be restored as quickly as possible after the work is completed. Advanced notice of any scheduled access restrictions will be provided to the residents and businesses. We ask for your patience in such instances. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times







Every effort has been made to reinstate as many asphalt driveways as possible prior to winter shutdown. However, as this is an active construction project, it has not been possible to reinstate every asphalt or concrete driveway due to current weather conditions. If your driveway has not been paved, you should anticipate that it will be remaining on gravel until in can be reinstated to its original condition or better, in Spring / Summer 2025. Thank you in advance for your patience, understanding and cooperation.

2025 Construction Schedule

Full construction activities will resume in Spring 2025. The work being completed in 2025 will mainly include driveway regrading and reinstatement, restoration works (topsoil and sod), completion of all concrete sidewalk, and paving of surface asphalt throughout the limits of construction.

Special Needs

We encourage residents with mobility limitations or other special needs to contact the project team so their specific needs can be addressed.

How Will My Services Be Affected?

Telephone, hydro, cable TV, sewer and gas services should not be affected by construction activities performed during the winter period, barring any unforeseen circumstances. You will be notified in advance as to when to expect any planned interruptions to your water supply. However, unplanned interruptions to services may occur. Your patience during these times is appreciated and the contractor is committed to restore the services as quickly as possible.

In the event of unplanned disruption to services, residents are requested to contact the representatives from the Town, GIP or Burnside that are listed at the end of the newsletter. Waste Collection: Any construction activity being completed during the winter period should not interfere with regular garbage/recycling pickup.
