Online Program Registration

To register from the comfort of your own home, visit wasagabeach.com and click the Recreation, Events & Facilities tab. There you will find links to our online registration and payment portal. Click Register and Pay Online to begin your registration process following these easy steps:

- 1. Login to your account or create a new account (Make sure you record your user name and password, save it in a memorable place). You will need:

- 2. Once logged into your account, go to Courses, make your selection, then click **Register Now.**
- 3. From the Shopping Cart, click Next.
 - You will accept and agree to the Town's Refund Policy and Participant Waiver and Indemnification Release.
- 4. Payment Processing:
 - Once you click on **process payment**, you will be required to enter your credit card info.
- **5.** Once your registration is complete, you will be emailed a receipt and a fillable Participant Waiver:

In Person Program Registration

In person registrations can be processed at the Recreation & Facilities Customer Service Desk located at the RecPlex (1724 Mosley Street), Monday to Friday from 10:00 am – 3:00 pm or at Wasaga Stars Arena (544 River Rd. W.) 8:00 am – 8:00 pm, 7 days a week. In person payments can be made by cash, debit, cheque, Visa, or Master-Card.

Program Waivers

All participants are required to complete a Participant Waiver Form prior to taking part in a Town program.

Program Changes

The Town of Wasaga Beach Recreation & Facilities Department produces two editions annually of this guide for residents and visitors. Department staff have worked hard to ensure this guide is accurate, however, due to the semi-annual format and release dates, there are occasions where changes are made to programs after this guide has been produced. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

First Come - First Served

All registrations will be processed in the order they are received. Registrations are not confirmed until the Recreation & Facilities Department receives payment. Due to level advancements, some programs may have advanced registration privileges.

HST

HST of 13% is charged on recreation programs for all registrants aged 15 years +.

NSF Cheques

We know mistakes sometimes happen, but if necessary the Town of Wasaga Beach will charge an administration fee of \$35.00 for each NSF cheque received.

Waiting Lists

Once a class is filled, interested registrants will be placed on a waiting list, and contacted if and when a space becomes available. No fee will be charged until the spot is offered and accepted.

Photographs/Video

Unless the participant or guardian indicates otherwise, Recreation & Facilities will assume permission for pictures to be taken to promote recreation.

Personal Information

Personal information is collected in accordance with the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act. R.S.O. 1990, c.M.56 under the authority of the municipal Act 2001,S.O. 2001,c25 and will only be used by the Town of Wasaga Beach, Recreation & Facilities Department for the operation of recreation programs.

Class Postponement/ Cancellations

Classes may be cancelled due to low registration. Participants are offered a full refund or transfer (based on availability). If it is necessary to cancel a class due to inclement weather, instructor illness, etc., every attempt will be made to re-schedule the class. However, if the class cannot be re-scheduled, the Recreation and Facilities Department will extend an existing class, or can be left "on account" for further program registrations. The Recreation & Facilities Department reserves the right to withdraw, postpone, cancel or combine classes, to limit/increase registration or change course locations at any time.

Transfers

Transfers from one course to another are permitted up to five business days prior to the start of the Recreation Program providing there is space remaining in the program.



Wasaga Stars Arena Public Skating Rules - Have Fun Safely

1. Wear Helmets and Skates: Only people wearing skates are permitted on ice. All skaters are strongly recommended to wear CSA certified Hockey Helmets for safety.

2. Moderate speed: skate at a controlled and moderate speed, avoid rough play and multi-player games such as tag and races.

3. Follow Directional Flow: Follow the directional flow indicated. Reserve the center of the ice for children and less confident skaters.

4. Enter/Exit Safely: Enter and exit the ice only through designated points. Never enter or be on the ice when Ice Resurfacer is in use.

5. Respect Others: Listen to ice marshals, be mindful of fellow skaters and yield to those moving at different speeds. Use positive communication.

6. No Food or Drinks on Ice: Keep the ice clean and avoid spills by refraining from bringing food or drinks onto ice.

7. No Using Your Cell Phones on the Ice: For safety, refrain from using cell phones while on the ice. Focus on your surroundings.

8. No Sticks or Pucks: Hockey sticks and pucks are not allowed on the ice during public skate times.

9. Report Hazards and Accidents: Report hazards, accidents and incidents to arena staff or ice marshals immediately.

10. Supervise Children: All children under the age of 10 must be accompanied by a responsible person 16 years of age or older.

DANGEROUS WINTER WATER CONDITIONS

GENERAL TIPS

- Be suspicious; you can't tell the strength of the ice by its appearance
- Before you head onto ice, check reported conditions with a local marina operator or snowmobile club
- Avoid travelling on ice at night. Only clear, hard ice is recommended for travel. Keep away from unfamiliar/ unknown ice
- If you must venture onto the ice, wear a thermal protection buoyant suit to increase your chances of survival if you fall through
- Before you leave shore, inform someone of your destination and expected return
- Assemble a small personal safety kit to carry with you, including a whistle, rope, ice pick and cell phone.

ALWAYS AVOID

- Thawed/recently frozen ice
- Slushy/rotten ice
- · Ice near moving water
- · Going on the ice alone

SELF-RESCUE TIPS

- Float on your stomach facing the shore
- Reach forward onto the ice shelf; do not push down on it
- Kick your legs to push your torso onto the ice
- Crawl/roll away from the hole
- If you can't climb out, float in the water and call for help
- Get medical help immediately

ASSISTING OTHERS

- Do not attempt to go on the ice
- Push or throw a stick, rope or floating aid to the victim
- Seek help fast. Call 911 for assistance
- Remember Reach, Throw... but DO NOT GO!
